



How To Get A Divorce Without Spending \$1,000's

- Step 1:** Know what the Texas state residency requirements are before filing an uncontested divorce.

- Step 2:** Determine what Court you will be filing your forms in.

- Step 3:** Gather all forms and decide which forms are needed for the initial filing based on your particular circumstances.

- Step 4:** Prepare your Original Petition for Divorce.

- Step 5:** File the Petition with the Court and pay filing fees.

- Step 6:** Notify your spouse that you've filed for divorce.

- Step 7:** Wait the 60-day waiting period.

- Step 8:** Complete the Final Divorce Decree and Waiver then meet with your spouse and have them sign Waiver and Decree.
- Step 9:** Prepare testimony for Court.
- Step 10:** Contact the Court and set a court date for uncontested divorce.
- Step 11:** Attend Court and present your case and have judge sign the Divorce Decree.
- Step 12:** As an alternative to **Step #10**, draft an Affidavit of Testimony and submit it to the court instead of making a personal appearance.
- Step 13:** Request a copy of the Divorce Decree from the Court's Clerk.
- Step 14:** Send your spouse a copy of Divorce Decree after the Judge signs the Decree.
- Step 15:** Change Driver's License and Social Security Card if necessary.

You have now finished the divorce process and at this point should celebrate your accomplishment. You can now legally start your life anew but I would be very selective about the next person I decide to marry. 😊
